The meeting began at 9:06 A.M, called to order by Chair, Barbara Annis.

NHDOT Decision Lens Exercise – Bill Watson

The meeting was handed over to Bill Watson from NHDOT. Bill began by asking TAC members to move to the table, handed out clickers, and gave an introduction to the exercise to the group. This is the third Ten-Year Plan process using the decision lens software. The software is used to evaluate projects by weighting the project selection criteria. Bill reviewed the handout he provided and explained the selection criteria as listed and what is meant by each criteria selection. This process allows participants to be objective as possible. Dean Williams indicated that the TAC subcommittee previously completed the scoring of projects, which will be applied to the final weighted selection criteria.

Bill continued noting there are nineteen combinations of selection criteria to be scored. He also discussed the role of politics in the Ten-Year Plan Process, stating that politics overall has less of an impact in the final Ten-Year Plan than in the past.

Voting of the selection criteria began. Ten TAC members were present and had clickers, however only eight participated. The following are the results of the ranking:
