This service will pick up individuals from their requested pick-up location, drop off at their polling location and will return a short time later for the return trip making it very convenient to get out and vote this election cycle. **This service is available to EVERYONE going to the polls in Belknap and Merrimack Counties on Election Day!**

To reserve a seat, call 603-225-1989 to schedule the service no later than 2:30pm November 4. Reservations are required. Those with reservations will receive a call the afternoon of November 4 with the pickup time window. For residents living along the CAT bus route with a polling location also along the route, our mobility manager can help plan the trip using our regular bus service.
